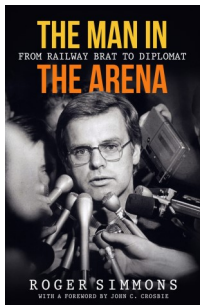

Roger Simmons is one of only two Salvationists to serve as a Member of Parliament; the other was Bandmaster Walter Dinsdale of Brandon, Manitoba. Roger's recently published memoir will be of special interest to Salvationists. It has a chapter on the Army and there are numerous photos and other references to the Army and its personnel, including Generals Larsson, Peddle,

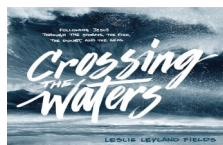
Bereavement Information and Support Group
